

Education – Diane Stiller

Since the last newsletter, we have had three more seminars: Deborah Bonnewell, Jamie Mills-Price, and Judy Ribitch.

Please review the stats for each of the seminars in the financial summaries that have been included in this newsletter.

In the Deborah Bonnewell oil class we learned two different methods of painting with oils. In the green gladiola class, we blended the oil paint on the line where the different values met. In the pink hibiscus class, after applying the various values of oil paint, we made a stroke through all of the values of paint to mesh the various values. Deborah donated one of her paintings of the green gladiola to our chapter.

The Jaime Mills-Price classes were filled with 35 students for the Santa and 36 for the Trick or Treat. Some of the things that we learned from Jaime are the following:

She doesn't float using a single stroke, but uses a series of shorter strokes.

She uses a pink pearl eraser that she dampens on a wet paper towel to erase small imperfections of paint on her surface.

When she applies Sno-Tex, she uses a brush and applies the Sno-Tex just like she is floating paint.

Jaime donated two pieces that she painted for our class raffles. This was very generous of Jaime as she usually does not do this. Jean Trimpe won the bear painted on a box and Sue Hazelton won the candlestick with pumpkins painted on it. Peggy Mack and Karen Capshaw each won \$25 worth of patterns or books of their choice. Jaime also donated both of the surfaces that she was demonstrating on to our chapter.


Also of special note was that Jaime mentioned that she was wearing a necklace that had her name "Jaime" on it and a bracelet with the word "Love". She received this from her sister and brother-in-law as a gift. What makes this so unique, is that they found these words in Jaime's mother's actual handwriting and gave it to an artist who fashioned those words out of silver. 




