## 2018 Anonymous Survey Results

A great big thank you to all the members who returned the survey. Your input helps guide us in the correct direction.

Here are the main Likes: It was close to unanimous that members most enjoyed the opportunity to get together with friends. Special events – such as Christmas Party, Spring Fling, Fall Retreat. Other likes were the variety of classes offered, Show and Tell and the Library.

Here are the main Recommends:

We cannot move the General Meetings to an earlier time because we cannot get into the building until after 5 o'clock. We cannot move Seminars to an earlier start time. As it stands now the Seminar Chair needs to leave their house by 7 o'clock to have a start time of 9 o'clock.






