
Memory Box Project





BIG DAISY MEMORY BOX

- 1. Transfer pattern not face very lightly with well worn graphite.
- 2. Moon Yellow paint center one coat only
- 3. Leaf Green float outer edge of leaves
- 4. White float outer edge of petals
- 5. Leaf Green line vein lines
- 6. Moon Yellow 2nd coat in center
- 7. Re-do petals and leaves, if necessary
- 8. Raw Sienna shade bottom half of center
- 9. White HL top half of center
- 10. Thinned Raw Sienna and liner softly apply face pattern
- 11. Red/Pink rouge cheeks
- 12. White, Yellow, Raw Sienna add dots around center




In December, we will have some sort of zoom Christmas gathering! We will be working on the details, and will get back with you at a later time.

Other news...


