## **Education – Diane Stiller**

Sixteen members attended Jane Allen's Woodsy Ornament zoom class. The Silicone Glove worked beautifully to keep the Quikwood from sticking to our hands. Jane spent a lot of time walking us through the process using the various sculpting tools and cutters. It's important to note that when you're ready to base coat the ornaments, that you use Adhesion Medium either alone or mixed with the first coat of paint so the paint adheres to the Quikwood more easily.

Nine members attended Kathy Ziemba's SDP's Paint-In zoom class using Kathy Swigon's Boo Pumpkins pattern. Kathy put her own spin on this design using Quikwood and Liquitex Light Modeling Paste. We learned how to make the spider web using non-stick foil and a glue gun. Jackie Wright on Kathy's behalf explained the process at the October meeting. Using a large ball stylus, you draw the pattern or word on the foil which makes an impression; then you trace the impression with the hot glue gun. The wax peels right off of the non-stick foil. Members mentioned that you can also use parchment paper that you can see through to help trace a pattern and the wax won't stick to it. Nice class Kathy! It was fun and we learned a few new things.







Eleven members attended Judy Westegaard-Jenkins' Autumn Smile class. It was interesting to learn that she favors using a white chalk pencil on the scrollwork. Judy also likes to use multiple layers of dry brushing to achieve her results.

She mentioned that she uses ice cube trays purchased from Dollar stores to hold her paint for the project she is painting. Cover the tray with Press and Seal unless the tray comes with a lid. Every once in a while you need to spritz the paint with water to keep it moist. She uses this method for conventions when she needs to bring paint for each student. The paint can last up to 3 weeks in the tray.

We will then paint them on our own which is pretty simple. Emails regarding purchase of class supplies were sent. Registration is now closed for this class.

**September 27**: Kathy Ziemba will teach the third SDP Paint-In: Boo Pumpkins by Kathy Swigon. Kathy Ziemba has added quikwood to the project on a paver. An email was sent regarding supplies and prep. This is a **free** class for members.

**October 1**: As you all know by now if you've been reading my emails, changes have been made to the Judy Westegaard-Jenkins' classes due to lack of participation.

The sailboat class, Postcards from the Sea, has been cancelled.

The Autumn Smile class will now be via **zoom** . Everyone will have to provide their own paint. Only 11 members are registered.

I sent out individual emails to each member who registered with information specific to them and how refunds will be issued. Members who are taking the Autumn Smile zoom class received information about the surface and stencil. 
## 3. Unsold item returns
