



Education – Diane Stiller

We spent two great days painting with David Bailey. The classes were very laid back and we all finished our paintings early. David showed us how to use a sponge to smooth out hard lines and blend the colors. We also splashed water with our fingers onto the painting and pounced a rag to absorb the water in order to create various shaped water drops. We used a toothbrush to not only splatter paint onto the surface, but used the side of the brush to create lines that ground the people to the pavement and rays of light from the lamp post. The turtle turned out to be a lot of fun. The background was more abstract, so we boldly flicked paint onto the canvas with our brush, used the sponge to even out hard lines, painted bubbles, and then David finished it off with airbrushing. Very enjoyable and technique packed classes.





